COMPETITION SCHEDULE	Arrival: At Nakhon Si Thammarat or Suratthani Airport on 2 April 2014 Competition: 4 – 6 April 2014 Departure: 7 April 2014 from Nakhon Si Thammarat or Suratthani Airport.
COMPETITION FORMAT	Country entry numbers: Maximum of 1 Men's and 1 Women's Team per each National Federation. Athlete Eligibility: - All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Youth Olympic Games. - To be eligible to participate in the Youth Olympic Games, athletes must be born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 1999. The competition format shall be decided by AVC according to the number of participating teams. In principle, the competition will be two phases, preliminary phase of round of robin followed by the 2 <sup>nd</sup> phase of Single Elimination format with classification matches to determine the top 6 ranked teams per gender.
AVC QUOTA	Top 6 teams of men's and women's will qualify for the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Summer Youth Olympic Games – Nanjing, China 2014.
PRELIMINARY INQUIRY & TECHNICAL MEETING	Players must attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present their uniforms and official forms and passport/travelling document (player's commitment, health certificate) during the inquiry. Players must also attend the General Technical Meeting(s). Draws will be made during the meeting; seeding and detail information on the competition will be distributed to players during the meeting. It is also mandatory for the players to present the ID card or Passport during the Preliminary Inquiry for the AVC Technical Supervisor to verify if the age comply with the regulation.
UNIFORMS	Uniforms will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Players of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts. The display of player's sponsor's logos on shorts and accessories is free as long as it complies with AVC advertising regulations. No uniforms will be provided by the organizer and it is a must that each team shall have minimum 2 sets of uniform in contrasting colors.
RULES OF THE GAME / BALL FORFEIT	As per FIVB Rules of the Game. The ball shall be the latest available Mikasa. Each NF is responsible for informing immediately both the AVC and Organizers

in case of forfeit of an enrolled team.

AVC OFFICIALS	The AVC will appoint 2 Delegates (1 Technical Supervisor and 1 Refereeing Delegate) and 3 Neutral Referees (FIVB Beach Volleyball International Referees).
ENTRY, SEEDING AND WITHDRAWAL	Seeding and Entry Regulations and Withdrawal: in accordance with the decisions of the AVC Beach Volleyball Council. Teams must be entered by 25 March 2014. Teams are also requested to register via <a href="http://www.fivb.org/vis">www.fivb.org/vis</a> . In case there is any problem regarding the registration on the FIVB database, please contact Mr. Yu Tsao ( <a href="mailto:yu.tsao.bv@gmail.com">yu.tsao.bv@gmail.com</a> ) or Mr. Chirs LIU ( <a href="mailto:njchrisliu@gmail.com">njchrisliu@gmail.com</a> ) of AVC Beach Department.
COACHING	Coaches must be approved by the AVC Delegate and desirably be accredited by the AVC as a minimum.
MEDICAL CONTROLS	The AVC reserves the right to perform random medical controls, as per FIVB rules and regulations.
PLAYERS ELIGIBILITY	Only players, who have sent to the AVC and the Organizer the required forms, will be considered eligible to take part in this event in Nakhon Si Thammarat, Thailand
INSURANCE	It is mandatory that all athletes have their own liability and medical insurance. The AVC and the Organizer will not be held responsible for any medical expenses incurred while competing in a tournament. Basic medical facilities will be available.
TRANSPORTATION	Players are responsible for their own international and domestic airfare and for any airport taxes, visa expenses (see later note on Visas), insurance etc. Players are requested to apply early enough for their entry visas, whenever needed. An invitation letter will be sent by the organizers if required. Teams must only fly directly to Nakhon Si Thammarat or Suratthani Airport  The organizer will welcome all participants (players and officials) at the 2 mentioned airports. The travel details of the teams must be sent to the event office by 30 March 2014.
BOARD & LODGING	The promoter will cover the board & lodging costs of all players of the participating teams from two days before the start of the tournament. Any other team members have to pay US\$ 60 for twin room and US\$ 80 for single room (Three meals and local transportation are included) during Preliminary Enquiry. All participants are however personally responsible for all and any extras at the hotel such as mini bar, phone calls, laundry, etc., that must be paid at checkout.
