COMPETITION SYSTEM	Competition format will be in accordance with the format applied by AVC Beach Volley Council.		
COMPETITION FORMAT	Country entry numbers: Maximum of 2 Women's Teams per each National Federation, only host National Federation can enter a maximum of 3 Women's Teams. The AVC shall determine the final quota in according with AVC ranking systems. The competition format shall be Pool play then single elimination. The competition shall last four days with organizers providing 1 centre court, 2 other COMPETITION courts and 1 warm up court.		
PRIZE MONEY	US\$ 15,000 prize money (for Women) to be paid by the organizer to participating teams as per following breakdown & upon conclusion of the event:

	Players must attend the Preliminary Inquiry and present their uniforms and official forms (player's commitment, health certificate) during the inquiry. Players must also attend the General Technical Meeting. Draws will be made during the meeting; seeding and detail information on the competition will be distributed to players during the meeting. Date, time & place for the preliminary inquiry and General Technical Meeting will be informed on team's arrival.		
UNIFORMS	Uniforms will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Players of the same team must wear the same color and style of

The display of player's sponsor's logos on shorts and accessories is free as long as it complies with AVC advertising regulations.</p> <p>The organizers may provide playing tank tops and/or tops (2 sets per player of contrasting colors) for the players</p> <p>Any sponsorship on individual players uniforms must not conflict with the AVC marketing regulations</p>
RULES OF THE GAME / BALL	<p>As per FIVB Rules of the Game (2012 updated on 13 August 2009, available at <a href="http://www.fivb.ch">www.fivb.ch</a>).</p> <p>The ball will be the AVC official partner, which is Mikasa that will be supplied by AVC.</p>
FORFEIT	Each NF is responsible for informing immediately both the AVC and Organizers in case of forfeit of an enrolled team.
AVC OFFICIALS	The AVC will appoint 2 Delegates (1 Technical Supervisor and 1 Refereeing Delegate) and Neutral Referees.
ENTRY, SEEDING AND WITHDRAWAL	<p>Seeding and Entry Regulations and Withdrawal: in accordance with the decisions of the AVC Beach Volleyball Council.</p> <p>Teams must be entered by <b>March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2013</b>.</p>
COACHING	Coaches must be approved by the AVC Delegate and desirably be accredited by the FIVB if necessary.
MEDICAL CONTROLS	The AVC reserves the right to perform random medical controls, as per AVC/FIVB rules and regulations.
PLAYERS ELIGIBILITY	Only players, who have sent to the AVC and the Organizer the required forms, will be considered eligible to take part in this event in Ha Long, Vietnam.
INSURANCE	It is mandatory that all athletes have their own liability and medical insurance. The AVC and the Organizer will not be held responsible for any medical expenses incurred while competing in a tournament. Basic medical facilities will be available.
TRANSPORTATION	<p>Players are responsible for their own international and domestic airfare and for any airport taxes, visa expenses, insurance etc to and from <b>Noi Bai, Hanoi Airport</b>.</p> <p>Players are requested to apply early enough for their entry visas, whenever needed. The organizer will arrange and be responsible for all local transportation for all participants and referees from the airport to Ha Long, from Ha Long to Noi Bai on the departure day if the teams inform the organizer of their itinerary in due time as below. An invitation letter will be sent by the Organizer if required.</p> <p>The travel details of the teams must be sent to the event office by <b><u>April 12, 2013</u></b>.</p>
BOARD & LODGING	<p>The promoter will cover the board &amp; lodging costs of all players of the participating teams from evening of 23<sup>th</sup> April (2 days) before the start of the tournament through to breakfast of April 29, 2013. Any other team members have to pay US\$ 60 for twin room and US\$ 80 for single room (Three meals and local transportation are included). All participants are however personally responsible for all and any extras at the hotel such as mini bar, phone calls, laundry, etc that must be paid at checkout.</p>
